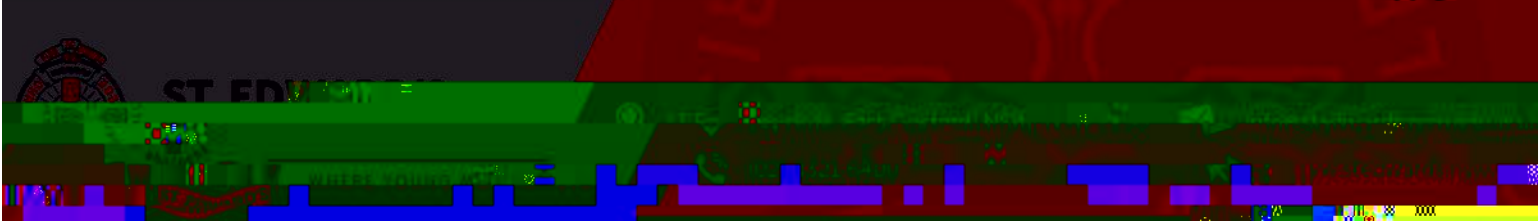
Introduction and Purpose
